ENTERING GRADES 5-6

Adventure Tales and Writing → Students will read short adventure and mystery stories to enrich their comprehension and build a foundation of literary skills and analysis. They will learn to break down the form of the adventure story while also taking a multi-sensory approach to the five purposes of writing, utilizing the six stages of the writing process. This fun workshop will provide practice in the arts of reading and writing.

Everyday Math → Students will have opportunities to explore mathematical concepts in relation to real life situations. Each math session will center on critical grade appropriate math skills. We look for common interests among the group and structure activities from everyday life in which those skills are used.
