Lower School Reading Program

ENTERING GRADES 2-5

This course is designed for students entering grades 2 through 5 who are struggling with the acquisition of reading on the phonetic or comprehension level. This is an intensive three-hour course that meets daily for four weeks. Students have small group instructions for *Phono-graphix*, *Read Naturally* (a reading fluency program), Comprehension Strategies and Word Study/Vocabulary. Additionally, every child will participate in an individual session of *Phono-graphix* each morning.

Reading instructors are McLean faculty with experience working with students who struggle learning to read. Manipulatives, memory strategies and language-based instruction techniques will be utilized to reinforce concepts.

Faculty will administer pre- and post-tests to document improvement. (McLean will administer the pre-test prior to acceptance in the program; contact the Summer Program Office for details.) At the conclusion of the program the teacher will write a short report for each student to communicate progress, as well as strengths and weaknesses.
